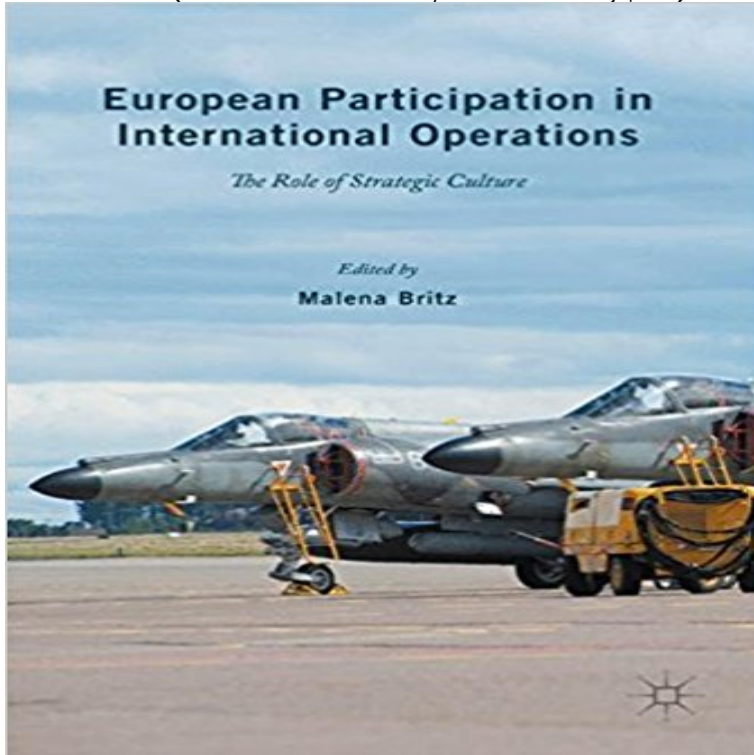


European Participation in International Operations: The Role of Strategic Culture (New Security Challenges)

Employing a theoretical framework of strategic culture, including aspects of civil military relations, this innovative volume seeks to answer these questions.
