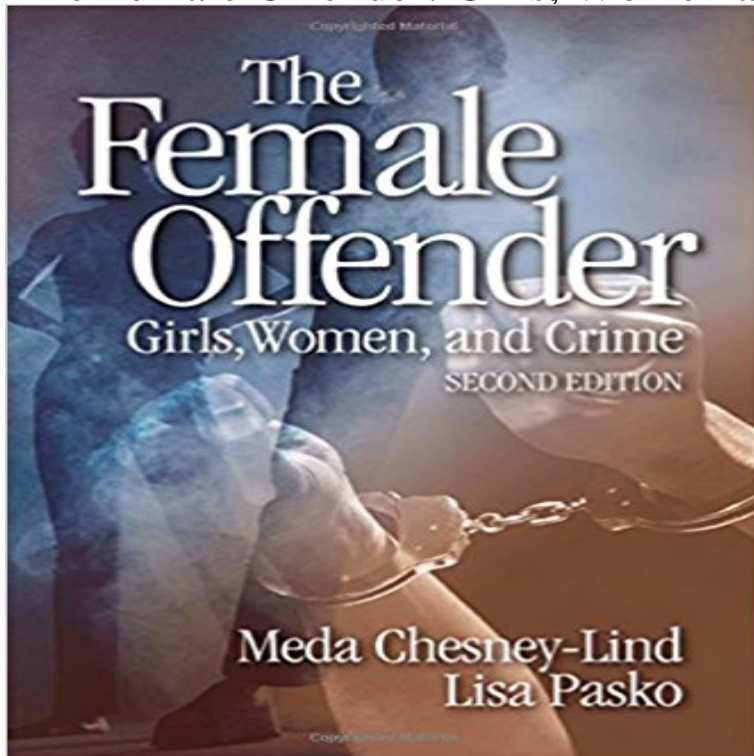


## The Female Offender: Girls, Women and Crime
