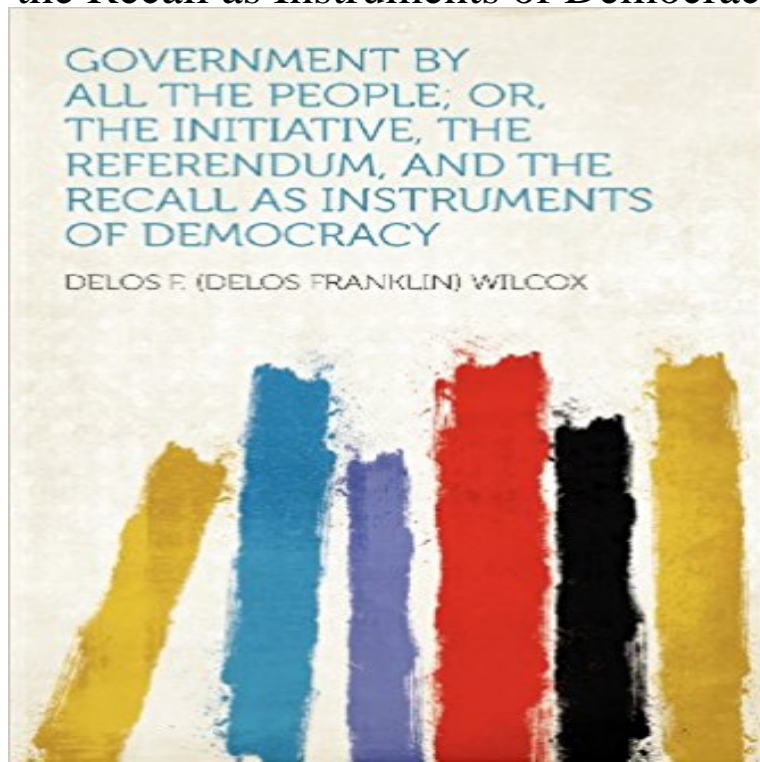


Government by All the People; Or, the Initiative, the Referendum, and the Recall as Instruments of Democracy
