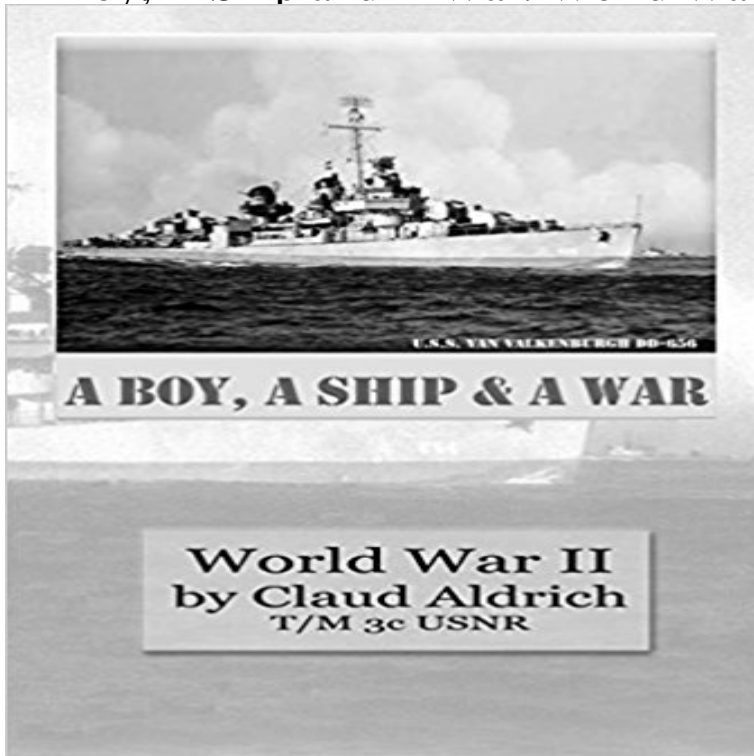


A Boy, A Ship and A War: World War II
