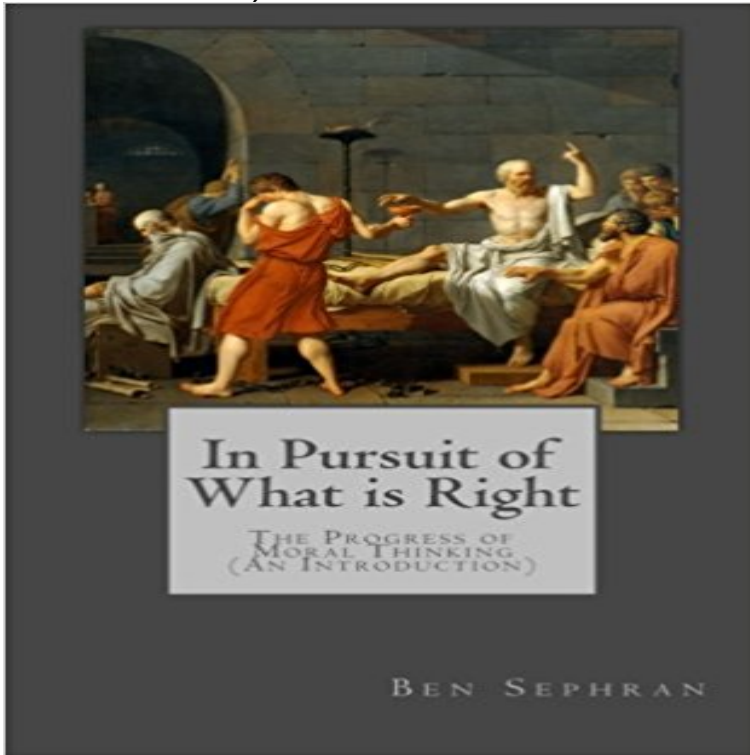


In Pursuit of What is Right: The Progress of Moral Thinking (An Introduction)
