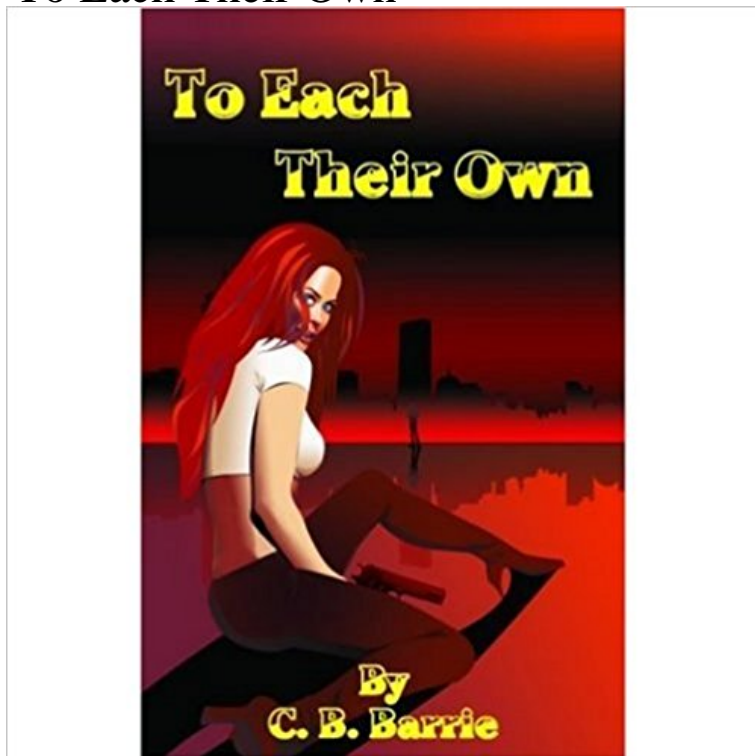


## To Each Their Own



To Each Their Own is a contemporary thriller. Coined from the idea of genetic manipulation, the central aspect is the search for a blood donor whose blood possesses miraculous restorative powers. What ensues from this search reflects the murderous greed and viciousness that can occur when it is realised that possession of the donor will give rise to wealth and fame for some, but the destruction of established institutions and society's structure and fabric for others. It is the battle between these two forces, individual and society, which are central to the story. Though the story unfolds as a thriller, it highlights the tension between the expectation of individual rights and society's double standards. Involved in the chain of events, which contrasts the difference between duty and self-serving excuses for duty, is a series of twists in circumstance which result in a terrible cost to all concerned. We are reminded of the harsh truth that the wrong thing can often be done for the right reasons, and this story re-assesses the age-old moral dilemma concerning whether doing wrong in pursuit of right is justified. Should we condone wrong if it serves the greater good and if so, what response do you make to an individual who holds the key to something utterly altruistic, the potential salvation of mankind, yet displays a nature and behavior wholly malevolent?
